PROCEDURES FOR SUBMITTING PAPERS :

Ph.D. students are expected to submit an English extended abstract (500-700 words, three keywords and JEL classification) in electronic form to the following address:

submitpaper2011@addegem-asso.fr

Submission should include the authors' name, affiliation, address, phone number and email.

Authors who want to present a paper are also asked to provide a short abstract (250 words) for publication in the conference abstract handbook.

AWARD

In this way, any interested students have to add, during the submission, a complete version of the article.
